RE: **PRELIMINARY DEVELOPMENT OF INFORMATION**

TO: All Parties Interested in the Post-2017 Allocation of Hoover Power

NOTE: *This is not an official notice to receive applications for the purchase of Hoover power. Section R12-14-201 of the Administrative Code of the Arizona Power Authority provides for the Arizona Power Authority to provide a preliminary proposal for the allocation and marketing of available long-term Hoover power. This memorandum is not an official notice and should not be construed as such.*

PURPOSE: To clarify that the “Request for Information” (emailed to all Interested Parties last Friday, May 4, 2012), was not a request for specific numbers from potential individual applicants; but, a request for general rate schedule information and how the potential Hoover 2017 applicants classify their power sales. More specifically, we are not, at this time, requesting numbers or metrics related to actual power use and sales. We are requesting information regarding the types of sales made by interested parties and ideas as to how to develop allocation methodologies that will be fair and reasonable for allocating Hoover power in 2017.

Based on discussions with current Power Authority customers and interested parties, it is clear that there is a wide range of rate classifications used for selling power to agricultural customers versus commercial loads, versus industrial loads. The purpose of the May 4th data request was to gather information on how power is sold to the ultimate customer so that meaningful data requests may be developed by the Power Authority in the future when we request load data information (numbers).
