**SUBJECT: PRESENTATIONS FOR ALLOCATION OF HOOVER POWER**

The Arizona Power Authority will hold a series of public meetings (Conferences) for those entities considering submitting applications for the 2017 allocation of Hoover power. The purpose of these Conferences is to provide an opportunity for those parties to make a presentation to the Power Authority Commissioners regarding their need for an allocation of Hoover power. We estimate we will schedule several Conferences over a number of weeks in order to accommodate all of the entities that will schedule presentations. We hope to complete these Conferences no later than November 2, 2012.

**This is not the start of the formal allocation process  
pursuant to R-12-14-101-et seq.**

At a minimum, we suggest that presentations made by potential applicants respond to the following questions:

- 1) What resources would you seek, such as:
  - a. Hoover "A" or Hoover "B" or Hoover "D" or a combination of the three
  - b. Transmission service
  - c. Supplemental power
  - d. Delivery at what location(s)
  
- 2) What do you plan to do with the Hoover power allocated to your system?
  - a. Agricultural use
    - (i.) Agricultural Processing – for example, cotton-gins, feed mills, agricultural product cooling
    - (ii.) Dairy related – milking refrigeration, etc.
    - (iii.) Packing houses, vacuum coolers, fruit and vegetable packing houses
    - (iv.) Irrigation only – groundwater pumping energy
    - (v.) Other

- b. Street lights
  - c. Water pumps for residential, commercial, industrial, etc.
  - d. Sewage treatment facilities
  - e. Residential service
  - f. Commercial service
  - g. Industrial service
- 3) How much Hoover power would you require?
- a. Capacity kW allocation
  - b. Energy kWh allocation
  - c. Timing flexibility for delivery (monthly, hourly, seasonally)
- 4) How much federal power do you currently receive?
- a. Capacity kW allocation by source (i.e., Hoover, Parker Davis, CRSP)
  - b. Energy kWh allocation by source (i.e., Hoover Parker Davis, CRSP)
- 5) How do you think the Hoover power should be allocated?

We request that applicants respond to this notice with dates and times (hopefully before September 30<sup>th</sup>) that would be most convenient for them to make their presentations. In addition, prior to the meetings, we ask that applicants provide us with:

- The name of the person(s) who will be making the presentation
- An estimated amount of time for the presentation
- An outline of the presentation
