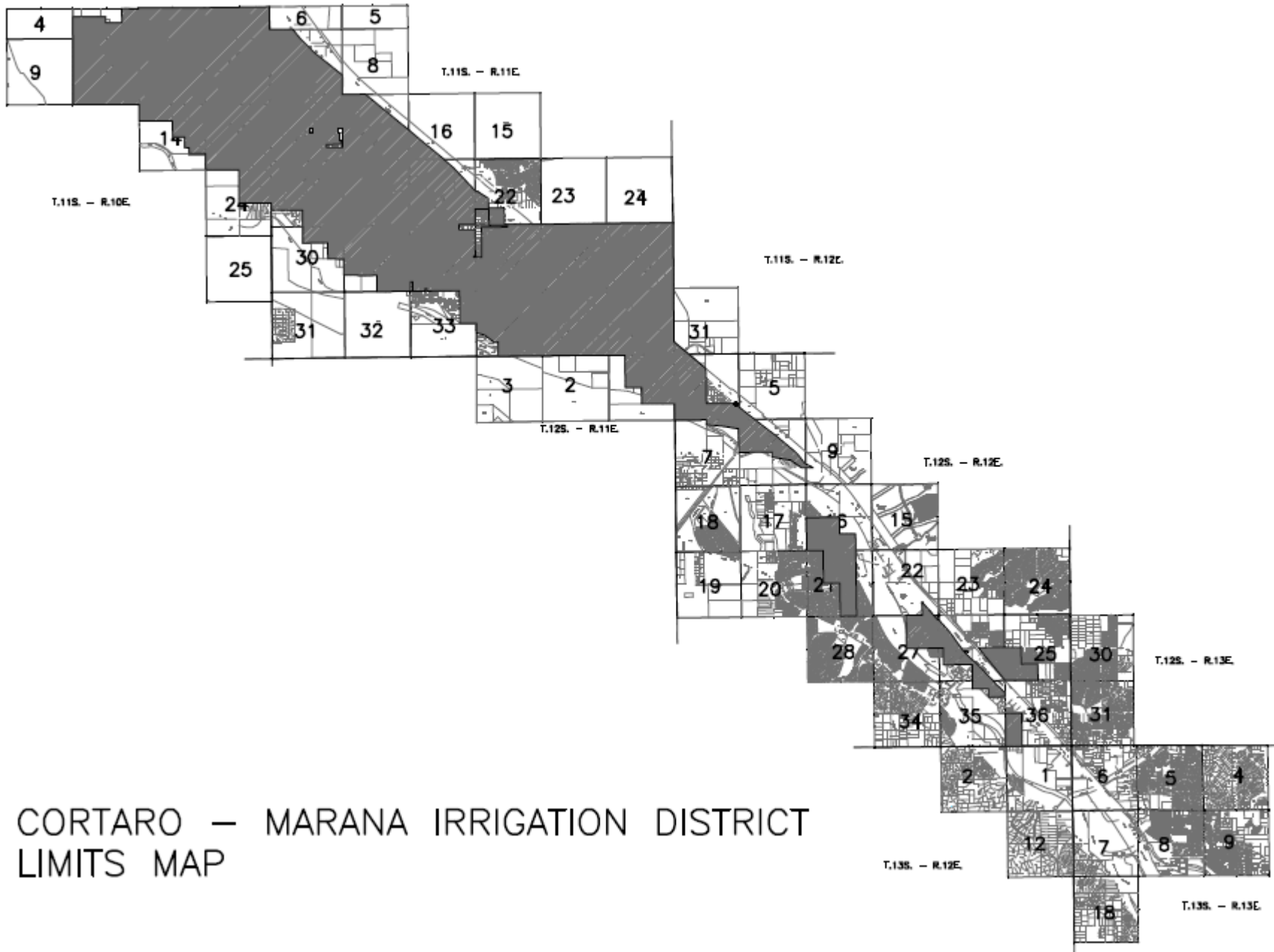

BACKGROUND

- CMID is a political subdivision of the State of Arizona formed pursuant to ARS 48 et seq.
- CMID was formed in 1961 for the purpose of delivering irrigation water to its customers. CMID's predecessor has been providing irrigation water since 1917.
- CMID owns and operates 44 wells for the delivery of water to its customers.
- CMID's service area consists of approximately 12,400 acres and currently has 10,800 irrigable acres in production.
