Re: Comments on APA Transmission Policy for Post-2017.

Dear Mr. Gazda:

On behalf of Mohave Electric Cooperative (MEC) and Navopache Electric Cooperative (NEC) the following comments are made in response to the APA request for comments.

As potential allottees of power and energy from the Boulder Canyon Project (BCP) from Western and/or the Arizona Power Authority, MEC and NEC would, in effect, be new BCP allottees and would prefer, request and ask that they be allowed to arrange for their own transmission of any allocations. Cooperatives prefer to not ask or be required to ask APA to get additional transmission for new APA/Western BCP allocations to them.

The proposed policy comment document was received on November 10, 2014 and the time-frame for response has been abbreviated and not allowed the Cooperatives sufficient time to more fully comment. However, as respective new allottees, if, as and when allocated BCP power, they prefer making their own arrangements for transmission separate and apart from APA arrangements on their behalf for BCP transmission.
