Subject: Post-2017 Transmission Policy

Mr. Gazda,

The City of Scottsdale appreciates the opportunity to provide comments relating to the Arizona Power Authority Post-2017 Transmission Policy. As a proposed allottee of post-2017 Hoover Schedule D1 power, the City has great interest in any transmission policy established by the Authority; and subsequent effects on transmission contracts and rates. As the City is a potential new power contractor, and in light of the fact that post-2017 allocations have yet to be finalized, as well as the limited 7-day comment period; the City finds that providing substantive and meaningful comments regarding the Authority's proposed transmission policy is both difficult and severely limited. We acknowledge that such policy evaluation is a necessary and worthwhile endeavor. However, as a potential new power contractor, sufficient time must be available to identify and evaluate various transmission options, contracting opportunities, and associated cost impacts. Therefore, the City is requesting that additional time be provided to adequately evaluate and comment on the Authority's proposed transmission policy and the associative impacts.

Thank you for your consideration. We look forward to continued discussion on this important matter.
