March 3, 2015 10:00 AM MST	Special Meeting On Policy and Legal Issues Affecting the Post-2017 Hoover Allocation Process	The Commission accepts comments on policy and legal issues and decides a preliminary position on the issues for inclusion in its Preliminary Proposal.
March 17, 2015 10:00 AM MST	Regular Commission Meeting	The Commission addresses any issues that remain after the March 3, 2015 Special Meeting.
April 3, 2015	Declaration that Long-term Power is available	The Authority declares that a supply of Long-term Power is available, gives notice of a Public Information Conference at which the Authority shall present Preliminary Proposal, and establishes a due date for applications for electric service.

April 10, 2015 10:00 A.M MST	Application Workshop	The Authority holds a workshop to answer questions and work with applicants to fill out their applications.
*April 27, 2015 5:00 PM MST	Applications for Electric Service Are Due	Parties seeking an allocation of post-2017 Hoover power must submit an application for electric service.
*May 18, 2015 10:00 AM MST	Public Information Conference & Preliminary Proposal	The Authority holds a Public Information Conference and provides a Preliminary Proposal.
*June 8, 2015 10:00 AM MST	Public Comment Conference	The Authority holds a Public Comment Conference where interested parties may appear and present comments on the Preliminary Proposal.
*June 26, 2015	Notice of Eligibility and Proposed Allocation	The Authority notifies all interested parties of the names and addresses of the prospective Purchasers that are eligible to enter into a Power Sales Contract and of the proposed allocation.
*Sept. 24, 2015	Draft Power Sales Contract	The Authority presents a draft form of contract to eligible Prospective Purchasers that received an allocation and begins contract negotiations.
